

Equipment Rio Grande

Clothes / Personal gear

Underwear – long and short - warm.
Long fleece underwear – Under waders.
T-Shirts – long & short sleeve.
Socks – also warm for wading boot.
Fleece jacket.
Warm jacket down.
Warm hat.
Fishing gloves - neoprene
Fishing cap.
Buff.
Shoes for camp life – type sandals
High waders – bring an extra pair.
Wading boots.
Fishing jacket / Vest.
Possibly a shirt and nice trousers for dinner

Miscellaneous

Passport – minimum 6 months expire date from last day of travel.
Cash money for tip and travel.
Lighter/matches.
Toiletries.
Smartphone.
Camera.
Charge cables for phone and camera.
Batteries for headlamp and other items.
Waterproof pouch for phone/camera.
Sunscreen 20-50+
Polarized glasses
Head lamp.
Wading staff.
Backpack waterproof.
Pliers / multi tool.
Repair kit for waders

Fishing gear

Single hand rod 9-10 ft. # 7-8 for nymph/streamer fishing. WF floating line #7-8.

Switch/two handed rod 12-14 ft. for nymph/streamer in windy conditions. Shooting head multi tip line # 8-10. Fly reel for WF 7 and WF 10 with good break and minimum 150 meters 30 lb backing.

Flies

Fly patterns very varied during the season and from pool to pool. Here are some flies you should not be without:

Small sunray shadow on tube

Bunny leech or String leech in black, purple, chartreuse and pink

Girdle, Yuk bug and Copper John rubber legged nymphs in size 4-12.

Princes or Peacock nymphs in size 10-14.

Bombers or foam flies in size 4-8.

Green machine in size 6-10.

Bitch Creek Nymphs in orange/black in size 4-12.

Tippet material and more

Monofil or fluorocarbon 0,25-0,40 mm. Tippet length 9-15 ft.
